ANNOUNCEMENT No. 1

1. Objective of the event:

- Establishing international sports contacts through sailing;
- Competition at an advanced level of sailing, held in a friendly and cooperative atmosphere;
- The event is open to all participants, providing satisfaction and an opportunity for deaf people from Poland and abroad to meet in sport;
- Promoting an active and healthy lifestyle among deaf people.
- Popularizing mass sports by organizing sports competitions for deaf people, promoting sailing, and fostering integration with international partners;
- Shaping attitudes toward "healthy competition" and promoting recreational forms of physical activity;
- Participants will be deaf sailors from Poland and abroad;
- The event is a preparatory stage for the World Deaf Sailing Championships.



4. Number of Participants

- Maximum **40** people

7. Conditions of Participation

- Crews: Each club and country may field a crew of 3-4 people; mixed crews are permitted.
- Buoyancy aids: mandatory while sailing - failure to wear one will result in disqualification.
- Sailing Instructions: will be provided during the technical briefing.
- Medical Examinations: Polish competitors must have a valid medical and sports examination.
- Deposit: PLN 1,000 or EUR 250 (collected before the race).
- Protests: submitted up to 1 hour after the end of the day's races, on a protest form, after payment of a PLN 100 fee.
- Participation Fee: Participation in the regatta is free of charge.

8. Regatta Rules

- The regatta will be sailed on Sportina 682 and Omega yachts in accordance with the ISAF 2025-2028 regulations, class rules, this announcement, and the sailing instructions.
- A maximum of 9 races are planned, using a transfer system.
- The regatta will be valid after a minimum of 3 races have been completed.
- Crossing the finish line after the closing time will constitute a failure to complete the race.
- Crossing the starting line before the starting signal will result in the need to correct the starting procedure in accordance with the sailing instructions.
- Yachts are provided by the organizer.

9. Scoring

- The final standings are determined by the total points earned in individual races (1st place - 1 point, 2nd place - 2 points, etc.).
- In the event of a tie, the final result will be determined by the number of better finishes in the completed races, followed by the better result in the last race.
- DNS - No Start: number of entered yachts + 1 point.
- DNF - Failure to Finish: number of entered yachts + 1 point.

- ISAF regulations must be followed and life jackets must be worn.
